## Petition No. 11 of 2021 House of Assembly

The petitioners ask the House to:


Endorse and support the upgrade of Queenborough Oval pursuant to the Queenborough Oval Master Plan.

### GOVERNMENT POSITION:

The Tasmanian Government recognises and supports quality facilities to enable opportunities for all Tasmanians to be involved in sport and active recreation.

### RESPONSE:

- The Hobart City Council (the Council) owns and manages the facility and in August 2015 endorsed the Queenborough Oval Precinct Master Plan (the Master Plan).
- The Tasmanian Government has committed \$2 million to assist the Council with infrastructure upgrades as part of stage 1 of the Master Plan.
- Hobart City Council has advised the Queenborough Working Committee to use the existing funds to build new change rooms, and to undertake a second stage in the future to build new club rooms once additional funds have been secured by Local, State or Federal Government.
- The Tasmanian Government remains committed to supporting the ongoing improvements of facilities to meet present and future facility needs of sport and recreation within Tasmania.
